The exercise price (if any) of the adjusted award is shown in Boxes 2 and 8, the number of shares subject to the adjusted award is shown in Box 9 and the number of shares added to the award pursuant to the adjustment is shown in Box 5.

3. These options are fully vested in accordance with their terms.

8. Shares underlying the stock option vest and become exercisable in four equal annual installments commencing on 2/18/2023.

9. Shares subject to the restricted stock unit award vest in four equal annual installments, commencing on 2/18/2023.

10. Shares underlying the stock option vest and become exercisable in four equal annual installments commencing on 2/23/2024.
